RULES AND GUIDELINES

Entries: Entries for competing and non-competing (schooling horses) must include a current Coggins, entry form, liability release and fees. Classes for Sunday's show require that the horse/rider combination be pre-qualified for the class. You must submit scores/copies of three tests for the level (one must be test C or 3) from either an Alpha Dressage schooling show, a SWFDA schooling show, or a Fox Lea Dressage show. These scores must be earned between October 1 and September 30th of the 2016-2017 show season. The guidelines for the GMO Championships are on our website. Entries must be hand delivered or mailed in. We will not accept any entries that are phoned or e-mailed in. Entries received after the closing date will be accepted at the discretion of the management. There are no refunds of any fees after 5 pm on Thursday prior to the show. Ride times for the schooling show will be assigned as the completed entries are received with preference given to the horse/rider combinations that are competing in the GMO Championships.

Fees: Fees for the schooling show classes are \$25.00 per class, for Alpha Dressage Association and SWFDA members, and \$30.00 per class, for non-members. The fee for the GMO classes is \$25.00 per class. There is a \$15.00 office fee per horse/rider combination per day. The fee for non-competing (schooling horses) is \$15 plus the office fee. If your check is returned for non-sufficient funds, you expressly authorize your account to be electronically debited or bank drafted for the amount of the check plus any applicable fees. The use of a check for payment is your acknowledgement and acceptance of this policy and its terms and conditions. Stabling: An overnight stall is \$40 and a day only stall is \$25. Stall cards will be placed on the stalls prior to the show. You must provide your own feed, hay, shavings and water buckets. If your horse will be staying overnight, you must make your own provisions for feeding at night and the next morning.

Payment: Make checks payable to Alpha Dressage Association and mail to: Robin Segó, 14555 Mossy Hammock Lane, Myakka City, FL 34251.

Schooling: There is no schooling in the show arena on the days of the show.

Footing: Sand arena 20m x 60m.

Approved helmets **MUST** be worn by all riders while mounted.

Riders under the age of 18 years must be accompanied by an adult while on the show grounds.

Correct tack will be required as defined by USEF – i.e. smooth snaffle bits – no twisted, wire, roller or Pelham bits. Martingales, side reins, draw reins, horse boots and bandages are not allowed. Dressage whip maximum length is 47.2" (120 cm) including the sash.

Hot weather show attire is allowed. This means any color breaches and polo shirts. T-shirts are not allowed. Age appropriate boots are also required.

Ride times will be emailed to each entrant and posted on the ADA website on Thursday prior to the show. Classes will **NOT** run in order.

Awards for the Schooling show Classes: Ribbons through sixth place. A high point award will be presented to the highest scoring riders (Adult, Jr, and western) of the day for the schooling show classes. Scores for the Schooling show classes will count toward ADA and SWFDA Year-End Awards and the GMO Championships for the 2017-2018 show season.

Awards for the GMO Championship Classes: Ribbons through sixth place and vouchers for ADA or SWFDA schooling show fees at future shows. A high point award will be presented for the highest scoring riders (Adult, Jr, and Western) of the day for the GMO Championship classes.

Any topics that are not specifically addressed in the above guidelines or any exceptions to the guidelines must be discussed with and approved by the show manager. Any violation of the show rules can result in your exclusion from this and future ADA events.
